




Bisse de Baar





Total length: Approximately 6 km.

Altitude: Between 850 and 700 metres.

Route time: Approximately 1.5 hours (without the return trip).

Location: Baar and Brignon are both in the locality of Nendaz, to the left

of the Rhône.

Difficulty: An easy walk without particular challenges through beautiful apricot orchards.

Ordinance Survey map 1:50'000 no. 273T Montana.

Best period: Early April to mid-November.

This bisse contains water from early April to late October.

Departure & Itinerary

If you come from the Bisse de Salins, when you arrive in Beuson, follow the old road that descends towards Brignon castle.

From Brignon castle descend towards the Printze and at the bottom of the village, when you reach the last barn, take the path through the barn which is made of two distinct buildings and follow the trail of the bisse as far as Pravidondaz.

From this point, you can catch a bus to go back up to your starting point.
