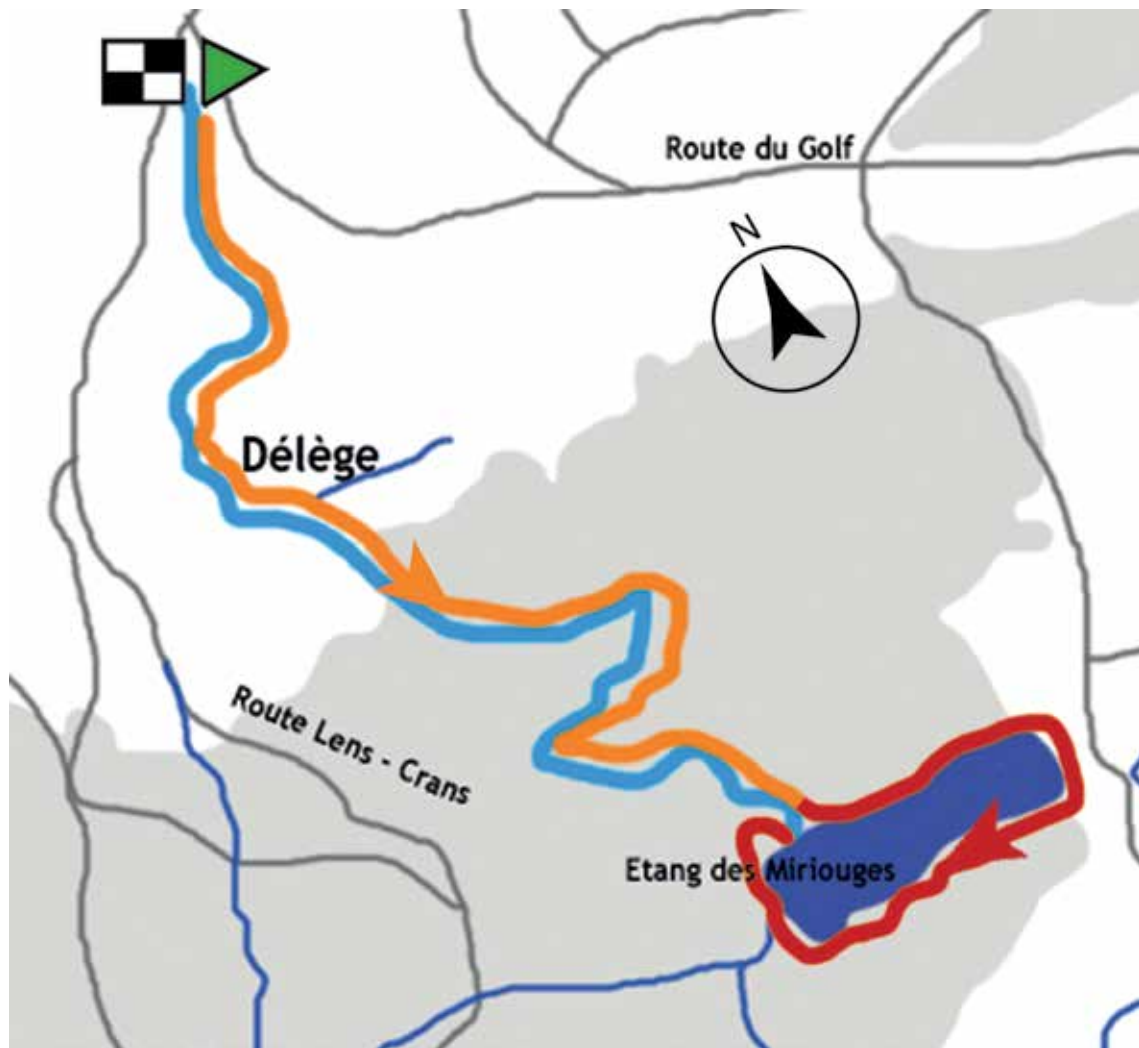


Bisse des Miriougues



Bisse des Miriougues

Built in the fourteenth century, at the same time as the Bisse du Ro.

Total length : 2.5 km.

Altitude : Between 1420 and 1330 metres.

Route time : Approximately 1 hour.

Location : Crans Montana, to the right of the Rhône.

Difficulty : There are no particular difficulties. The path is suitable for push-chairs and those with reduced mobility. There are a number of picnic places and a playground at the Miriougues lake.

Ordinance Survey map 1 : 50'000 no. 273T Montana.

Best period : May to November.

Departure & Itinerary

Begin your walk between Crans and Lens at the Blanche Neige restaurant. There is a bus atop in front or, if you drive, you can easily find parking nearby. The bisse begins to the right of the Route du Golf about 100 metre above the restaurant, or 50 metres below the «Les Ehripis» bus-stop on the Route du Golf (GPS 46°16'28" N 7°26'55" E). Take the tarmac road along the bisse before joining the path itself. Follow the sign-posts for «Helsana Trail». The bisse goes as far as the Miriougues lake.

A shady path suitable for push-chairs and those with reduced mobility. At the Miriougues lake there are a number of picnic places and a playground to the south-east.
